

KS4 Outcomes 2023 •Over **70%** in Year 9 achieved at least one GCSE at grades 9-4 or equivalent.

•96% in Year 10 gained a GCSE course RS.

KS4 Outcomes 2023 Excellent Year 11 outcomes which included:

- 70% of all entries were at grades 9-4
- Nearly **25%** of all entries were at the top grades 9-7.
- 11% were at the challenging grades 9&8
- Achievement in the Core Subjects is strong
- Nearly 70% of the cohort gained grades 9-4 in English and Maths
